



## **2023 SGMP CHAPTER BOARD “CALL FOR NOMINATIONS”**

The Florida Capital Chapter of the Society of Government Meeting Professionals is looking for leaders! Nominations are now being accepted for all five elected positions\* on the 2023-2025 Florida Capital Chapter Board of Directors. The incoming chapter board shall be sworn in during the chapter meeting/event nearest to, but before July 1, 2023. Their term of office will run from July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2025. Any chapter member in good standing for at least six months (in the category noted below) prior to nomination shall qualify for nomination to and election on the chapter board of directors:

<b>President</b>	(Government Planner or Contract Planner)
<b>First Vice President</b>	(Government Planner or Contract Planner)
<b>Second Vice President</b>	(Supplier)
<b>Secretary</b>	(Government Planner or Contract Planner)
<b>Treasurer</b>	(Supplier or Contract Planner)

This year’s election timeline is as follows:

- Chapter nominations must close by 3/17/2023
- Chapter membership online voting opens on 3/30/2023
- Chapter membership online voting closes at 5:00pm ET on 4/5/2023
- Chapter election results are announced to entire chapter by 4/10/2023
- New chapter board members must be installed by 6/30/22
- Code of Ethics form (signed by all new chapter board members) must be received at SGMP by 7/31/2023
