"Hotel Safety & Security"

SGMP Capital City Chapter started off the year with an informative program presented by Janet Roach, Meetings & Conventions Director for Visit Tallahassee about Hotel Safety and Security: Looking Beyond the Peephole, a Gilmer Institute of Learning Presentation created by Charles Sadler, CGMP, CHSP and CHSC.

This topic has great importance for our membership as we either supply meeting space and services or are responsible many times for meetings planned within a hotel. Specific take away lessons included: 1) Being able to name safety and security features of a hotel 2) Key safety concerns that should be addressed in your RFP 3) How to determine which questions to ask on site visits.

During the presentation attendees were actively engaged and many offered tips and suggestion they use in their work and travel. Some tips offered include:

- Staying on a floor under 6 as this is as high as a firefighter ladder can reach
- Travel with a flashlight in case of power outage
- Always use the main entrance of a hotel after dark
- Cover your luggage tag at check-in to prevent a dishonest person from accessing your room using your name
- Verify that all windows and doors are locked upon entrance to your room.
- Leave the radio or TV on low volume when leaving the room to convey an occupied appearance

Adriane Stephens a mother of seven children ages ranging from 16 years-old to 6 year-old twins is trying to find a new home for her children.

An electrical fire burned everything inside their mobile home on the 2800 block of Cathedral Drive Sunday January 2nd.

The family has been roaming from hotel to hotel with the help of local agencies. Her children don't have any toys to play with at the hotel room, but when you ask them what they miss the most, they will tell you their clothes and having a home.

Stephens tells us, she's had a rough several months. One of her children was battling cancer, her fiancé lost his job and she's helping to take care of her sick mother.

Stephens says she's grateful to the churches and agencies providing assistance but says she's going to need all the help she can get.
